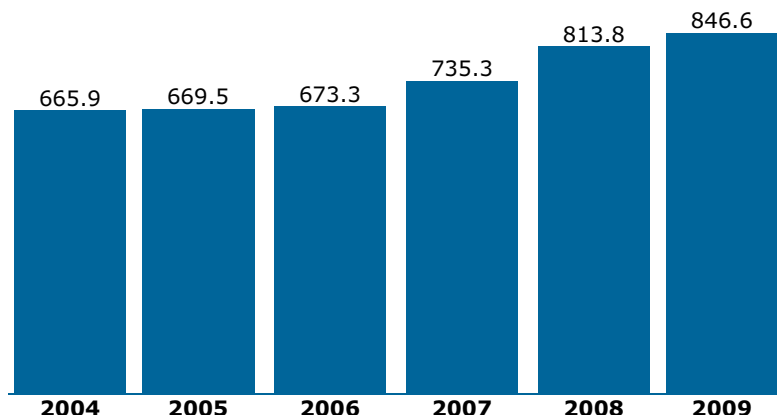


Fact sheet: Amtrak in Oregon
